## PALESTINIAN AUTHORITYDr Iyad al-Sarraj, human rights defender

Dr Iyad al-Sarraj, a prominent human rights defender, who was arrested on 18 May, remains in custody in Gaza. He was questioned about a recent interview he gave to the *New York Times* on 6 May 1996 in which he was critical of human rights abuses in the Palestinian Authority.

On 21 May his detention was extended "for questioning" by the State Security Court for a further 15 days. No lawyer was present during the hearing which was before a military judge. On 22 May Amnesty International was able to telephone Dr Iyad al-Sarraj where he is imprisoned in the Police Headquarters in Gaza. No charge has yet been filed against him, and part from his brief appearance before a military judge on 21 May, he does not appear to have been questioned since his initial interrogation on 18 May.

On 23 May, in a meeting with the legislative council, President Yasser Arafat's spokesman said that he would instruct judicial authorities to "free all prisoners being held without charge", when asked to release Dr Iyad al-Sarraj.

## FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express/airmail letters in Arabic or English or in your own language:

- expressing concern that Dr Iyad al-Sarraj remains held in detention without charge;
- demanding his immediate and unconditional release, as a prisoner of conscience;
- calling on the Palestinian Authority to ensure that organizations and employees engaged in protecting human rights and in monitoring human rights violations are supported and protected.
