JORDAN Ibrahim Hamdi 'Atia Mursi (m) aged 32

Amnesty International has learned that Ibrahim Hamdi 'Atia Mursi is no longer at risk of deportation to Egypt. According to reports, he continues to be detained in Jordan pending re-settlement but is not in danger of ill-treatment.

Ibrahim Hamdi 'Atia Mursi, an Egyptian national resident in Jordan for seven years, was arrested by the General Intelligence Department (GID) on 20 February 2003 apparently in relation to his activities in establishing a new Amnesty International group in Jordan.

Amnesty International will continue to monitor Ibrahim Hamdi 'Atia Mursi's case. Further action from the UA network is not required at present. Many thanks to all who sent appeals.
