LEBANONAhmed Hallaq

It has just been reported that on 20 August 1996, a Lebanese amnesty committee confirmed the death sentence imposed on Ahmed Hallaq. The 10-judge committee, which routinely reviews death sentences passed by lower courts, will now send the decision to President Elias Hrawi for either approval or amnesty.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express/ airmail letters in English, French, Arabic or in your own language:

- expressing regret at the confirmation of Ahmed Hallaq's death sentence, and calling for it to be commuted;

- stating unconditional opposition to the death penalty and urging that no further executions take place in Lebanon;

- urging the Lebanese Government to sign the Second Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights aimed at abolishing the death penalty.
