Amnesty International has received the names of six more people reported to be currently detained incommunicado in connection with the prohibited <a href="Hizb\_al-'Amal\_al-Shuyu'i">Hizb\_al-'Amal\_al-Shuyu'i</a>, Party for Communist Action (PCA). They were reportedly arrested in February and March 1992 in various towns and cities by members of <a href="al-Mukhabarat\_al-'Askariyya">al-'Askariyya</a>, Military Intelligence. Mahmud al-Khatib is reported to have been arrested on 1 February and to be detained for membership of the PCA. The other five are Amjad Kallas, a 38-year-old businessman, Jamal Salih Sa'id, a former prisoner of conscience aged 33, 'Abd al-Karim Darwish, a Palestinian engineer aged 33, Jaffan Humsi, a former prisoner of conscience aged 33, and Salama George Kila, a Palestinian writer and journalist aged 37.

The six were all arrested in February and March 1992 apparently in order to obtain information from them about the PCA. Some had been active in the PCA in the past and as a result had been detained for years without charge or trial. They are said to have had no links with the PCA since their release. Most of them were released in 1991. One, Salama George Kila, had apparently never been a member of the PCA, although he is said to be reputed to have friends and contacts who are active members of the party.

All 13 detainees are believed to be held in  $\underline{Fara'}$  al-Tahqiq al-'Askari, Military Interrogation Branch, and  $\underline{Fara'}$  Falastin, Palestine Branch, detention centres, both in Damascus.

Amnesty International fears that all 13 detainees are at risk of being tortured. In addition, the organization is concerned that they may be held solely for the non-violent expression of their political beliefs and as such would be prisoners of conscience. If this is so, they should be released immediately and unconditionally.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Telegrams/telexes and airmail letters:

- expressing concern at reports that the 13 detainees named above are being held incommunicado following their arrest in recent months and that they may be tortured;
- seeking assurances that they are being treated humanely and are not being subjected to torture or ill-treatment;
- requesting that all detainees be given prompt access to their families and lawyers, and all necessary medical care;
- asking for their immediate release unless they are to be charged with a recognizably criminal offence and given a prompt and fair trial.
