SYRIA 'Abdel Rahman Shaghouri (m), aged 31

Prisoner of conscience, 'Abdel Rahman Shaghouri, has been moved to Sednaya Prison, on the outskirts of the capital Damascus. It is not known whether any charges have been brought against him, though he is at risk of being tried before a military or state security court whose procedures and trials are known to be seriously flawed.

'Abdel Rahman Shaghouri is being held solely for exercising his right to freedom of expression including using the internet. He is not known to have committed any recognizably criminal offence or to have used or advocated violence, and is therefore considered to be a prisoner of conscience.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Internet access in Syria is carefully monitored by the authorities and websites deemed undesirable for political or moral reasons are censored. The cost of internet use is, in any case, beyond the means of most Syrians. Unfettered access can only be achieved by dialling internet service providers in neighbouring countries. Ironically, President Bashar al-Assad was formerly head of the Syrian Computer Society.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send appeals to arrive as quickly as possible, in English, Arabic, French, or your own language:

- urging the authorities to allow 'Abdel Rahman Shaghouri immediate and unrestricted access to his family, lawyer and whatever medical care he may require;

- calling on the authorities to guarantee that he is not tortured or ill-treated in detention;

- calling for his immediate and unconditional release as a prisoner of conscience, detained solely for exercising his legitimate right to freedom of expression.
