LAWYER AND HUMAN RIGHTS ACTIVIST RELEASED

Sudanese lawyer and human rights activist Magdi Saleem, who was arrested by the National Intelligence and Security Service in September 2013, was released from detention in October 2013.

Magdi Saleem was arrested on 24 September 2013 by the National Intelligence Security Services (NISS) after taking part in demonstrations against the government lifting fuel subsidies in Sudan.

We have now been able to confirm that Magdi Saleem was released in October.

Magdi Saleem was one of hundreds of activists in Sudan detained by national security officials during last year's protests.
