Rebuttal of a statement by a non-authorised person in the Democratic Republic of Congo

Amnesty International has issued a formal rebuttal of statements made by a certain Mr Géoffroy Claise Youlou at a press conference he held with two other organisations on 8 December 2011 in Kinshasa, in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). Consequently, all documents, statements and messages distributed by whatever means by Mr Géoffroy Claise Youlou, his representatives or any other person or organisation connected with him or this press conference must not be attributed to Amnesty International.

Mr Géoffroy Claise Youlou is not in any way connected to Amnesty International. He is neither an employee or member of the organisation.

Amnesty International does not have an office in either the Republic of Congo or the Democratic Republic of Congo, and neither does it have representatives authorised to speak on its behalf resident in either of these two countries. Amnesty International members resident in the DRC and the Republic of Congo are not authorised to present the positions taken by Amnesty International.
