Mexico: Amnesty International Secretary General visits the country – Itinerary UPDATE

Amnesty International Secretary General Irene Khan will lead a High Level Mission to Mexico commencing on 31 July.

Amnesty International's (AI) delegation will include: Susan Lee, Director of the Americas Programme; Judit Arenas, Head of the Office of the Secretary General; Rupert Knox, Researcher on Mexico and Nancy Tapias-Torrado, Campaigner on Mexico.

This is the third time Irene Khan leads a visit to Mexico since 2003 and the first to take place under the new administration.

17:30 – 18:30 -- Irene Khan will lead a meeting with Mexico's National Supreme Court to discuss the role of the judiciary in addressing human rights violations in Mexico.
