USA/UK/Denmark: Release of detainees

Amnesty International welcomes today's announcement of the return of one Danish and five UK nationals from Guantánamo Bay.

"We are pleased that these individuals will be returned to their home countries. We remain concerned, however, about the fate of all others who continue to be held in Guantánamo, particularly those who may face trial by military commission."

"We must not forget that there are hundreds of others who continue to wait in legal limbo whilst 'decisions' are made about their fate."

"We urge governments around the world to urgently make representations on behalf of all those held at Guantánamo Bay. *All* detainees should be afforded their full rights and should either be released or charged with a recognizably criminal offence and tried in court proceedings that fully meet international fair trial standards."
