Justice for Wazir Mohammad, Guantanamo detainee

Summary

Three months after Amnesty International (AI) launched this web action, Wazir Mohammad was flown back to Afghanistan, where AI delegates met with him in February 2004. Wazir Mohammad lost more than a year of his life in a legal black hole on the other side of the world. AI has seen no information indicating that this happened for any other reason than that he was in the wrong place at the wrong time. He was never given a chance to challenge the lawfulness of his detention in a court or to seek legal advice. AI continues to campaign on behalf of individuals detained at Guantanamo Bay.
