## **DEATH SENTENCES AND EXECUTIONS IN 1882**

During 1992, 1,708 prisoners are known to have been executed in 35 countries and 2,697 sentenced to death in 62 countries. These figures include only cases known to Amnesty International: the true figures are certainly higher.

As in previous years, a handful of countries accounted for the majority of executions recorded. Amnesty International recorded 1,079 executions in China and 325 executions in Iran, but the true figures were believed to be higher. These two countries alone accounted for 82 per cent of all executions recorded.
