The soldier who took Diomède Buyoya to the *Brigade spéciale de Rercherche* (BSR), Special Investigation Unit, where he died in custody, has been arrested, accused of his murder.

Diomède Buyoya worked for the soldier's wife, who accused him of insulting her. The soldier, a BSR investigating officer, took him into custody on 12 February, and he died the following day, apparently as a result of torture.

The soldier has yet to be officially charged and investigations by military judicial officials are continuing. He is in detention at Mpimba Central Prison, Bujumbura.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/faxes/express/airmail letters in French or your own language (please check with whether postal services to Burundi are operating from your country):

- welcoming the inquiry into the death in custody of Diomède Buyoya, and requesting that Amnesty International be informed of its outcome;
- expressing grave concern for the safety of scores of people in military detention in Bujumbura, particularly the BSR, after reports of systematic torture and ill-treatment;
- calling for immediate steps to be taken to protect detainees held at the BSR, mentioning those named above, and asking that they be granted access to their families, medical care, and humanitarian and human rights organizations; calling for the accusations against detainees at the BSR to be promptly investigated and asking for their release if they are not to be charged on the basis of substantiated evidence;
- calling for proper registration of all detainees in military and civilian custody.
