Chief Mondi, Chairman of the Social Democratic Front (SDF) electoral district in Pinyin, Mezam Division, North-West Province, was released without charge on 17 December 1997, almost two months after his arrest. He had been arrested on 22 October, apparently accused of preventing the presidential election of 12 October from proceeding.

He was among dozens of SDF members and supporters arrested and detained before and after the presidential election. The SDF, together with opposition political parties, had called for a boycott of the election. Most, if not all, appeared to be prisoners of conscience. All were subsequently released without charge.
