EQUATORIAL GUINEA: Norberto "Tito" Mba Nze

Amnesty International has learnt that Norberto "Tito" Mba Nze was released from Akonibe police station, sometime between 15 and 22 March 1994. He had been arrested in Akonibe on 28 February 1994. He had been severely tortured and had sustained damaged to the kidneys for which he was denied medical treatment.

**FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express and airmail letters either in Spanish, French or in your own language:**

- welcoming the release of Norberto "Tito" Mba Nze;
- expressing concern about reports that he was severely tortured;
- calling for a public inquiry into these reports and for those responsible to be brought to justice.
