Further information on UA 28/96 (AMR 19/05/96, 2 February 1996) - Fear for safety / Extrajudicial execution and new concern: Death threats

BRAZILWitnesses and relatives of those killed in the 1993 Vigario Geral massacre Members of staff of the *Casa da Paz*, Vigario Geral Fábio Gon_alves Cavalcante, aged 22 Edval Silva, aged 18

Amnesty International remains gravely concerned for the safety of relatives of those killed in the Vigario Geral massacre in August 1993, of witnesses to the massacre, and of staff members of the *Casa da Paz* (Peace House) in the Vigario Geral *favela* (shanty town), Rio de Janeiro. Threats against witnesses and relatives have increased since the conditional release on 16 February 1996 of 18 of the policemen accused of carrying out the massacre.

Pre-trial proceedings against 51 policemen accused of the Vigario Geral massacre reached an important stage on 16 February 1996 when the judge in the Vigario Geral case ruled that 18 of the defendants be released pending trial. A new witness has recently submitted testimony against one of the released defendants, and is due to be called to make an identification. In the past, attempts have been made on the lives of witnesses to massacres by police death squads in Rio de Janeiro. Lawyers representing the families of the victims are concerned that the safety of this new witness and other witnesses to the massacre may be in danger following an increase in anonymous telephone threats to them via the *Casa da Paz* since 16 February.

A police inquiry has been opened into the apparent extrajudicial execution of Fábio Gonçalves Cavalcanti and Edval Silva in Vigario Geral on 25 January 1996 (not 27 January as originally reported), but no one has been charged with the killings. The circumstances of the killings suggested that they were intended to intimidate the community.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/faxes/express/airmail letters in Portuguese, Spanish or English or your own language:

- urging the authorities to take immediate steps to guarantee the physical safety of all witnesses to the Vigario Geral massacre, in particular those who have recently made depositions;

- expressing concern at continued police harassment of the Casa da Paz;

- urging the authorities to immediately institute effective witness protection programs;

- reiterating calls for a full investigation into the killings of Fábio Gonçalves Cavalcanti and Edval Silva on 27 January 1996, and for those responsible to be brought to justice.
