Haiti: Amnesty International representatives visit the country to monitor housing rights

Two Amnesty International delegates – Chiara Liguori, researcher on the Caribbean, and James Burke, campaigner on the Caribbean – will visit Haiti to monitor the right to adequate housing in post-earthquake Haiti and commemorate, together with local NGOs, World Habitat Day on 7 October.

From now until 7 October they will be visiting different camps of internally displaced people (IDPs) and hold meetings with Haitian authorities and several local NGOs.

According to Amnesty International's latest report on housing and forced evictions in Haiti, [*Nowhere to go: Forced evictions in Haiti's camps for displaced people*](#), forced evictions threaten nearly a quarter of the more than 278,000 people still living in camps more than three and a half years on from the earthquake.

Both Chiara Liguori and James Burke will be available for interviews from 4 October onwards.
