Amnesty International has learned that John Sterling Gardner, who was scheduled to be executed by the state of North Carolina, USA, on 10 January 1992, has received an indefinite stay of execution. The reason for the stay is not known. No further action is required on his behalf. Thank you to all who sent appeals.

Appeals should continue on behalf of Anson Avery Maynard who is still scheduled to be executed on 17 January 1992.
