Further information on UA 38/98 (ASA 26/01/98, 6 February 1998) - Fear for safety / Possible prisoners of conscience

Twenty of the 33 men and women held in incommunicado detention since their arrest at a Bible study meeting on 31 January were reportedly released on 13 February 1998. They had been held at Wattay prison in Vientiane. The remaining 13 are still detained at Thatdam prison, Vientiane. It is not known if they have been charged with any offence.

The 13 include Khun Sy, the owner of the property where the Bible study meeting was being held, and his two sons, Bounlerth and Chan, and 18-year-old daughter Duangmanee. Bounlerth is Health Coordinator for *Partners in Progress* and has a pregnant wife. Khonmanee and Khet, both married with children, were working on a well drilling team for *Partners in Progress*, and Phengsy is a Health Trainer. Khammieng and Kaljaruengsuk are both farmers. Phakhamphim, Vienkham and Phakhamporn are reported to have led midweek Bible study classes.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/express/ airmail letters in English or French or in your own language:

- welcoming the release of 20 men and women detained since their arrest at a Bible study meeting on 31 January;

- urging the authorities to guarantee the safety of the 13 who remain in detention at Thatdam prison, Vientiane, and ensure that they are treated in accordance with international minimum standards;

- urging that the 13 be allowed immediate access to their families, lawyers and doctors;

- expressing concern that the 13 are prisoners of conscience detained solely for exercising their rights to freedom of belief and worship, and calling for their immediate and unconditional release
