GERMANYFathelrahman Abdallah

Amnesty International has learned that Sudanese asylum seeker Fathelrahman Abdallah is due to be deported to Sudan from Germany on 26 June 1999. In Sudan he would be at risk of serious human rights violations, including arbitrary imprisonment and torture. He is due to be deported despite the fact that the courts have not yet reached a final decision on his claim for asylum.

Fathelrahman Abdallah reportedly fled Sudan after being repeatedly imprisoned and tortured because of his active membership of the opposition Democratic Union Party of Sudan (DUP).

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please continue to send telegrams/faxes/e-mails/express/airmail letters in English, German or in your own language:

- urging the German authorities to abide by their international obligations under the principle of *non-refoulement*, and afford Fathelrahman Abdallah effective and durable protection from *refoulement*;
- urging the German authorities to ensure that asylum-seekers are allowed to stay in the country pending a final decision on their asylum claims.
