TURKEY Eren Keskin (f), lawyer and member of Istanbul HRA

On 2 June 1995, Eren Keskin, who was arrested on 1 June, was brought to Bayrampa_a prison in Istanbul to serve a two years and six months' sentence. Amnesty International considers her to be a prisoner of conscience.
