

URGENT ACTION

ALL 36 DETAINEES RELEASED

The 36 Iranians detained by the Iraqi security forces were released on 7 October, and have been taken back to Camp Ashraf.

The 36 men, who had been arrested in Camp Ashraf in July, had been held at a police station, some 25km from the camp, and then moved to a military airbase in Baghdad, despite a judicial order for them to be released. They maintained a hunger strike while they were in custody, and most were in poor health when they returned to Camp Ashraf.

No further action is requested from the UA network. Many thanks to all who sent appeals.
