CAR: Increasing tension and alarming humanitarian situation

The security and humanitarian situation in the Central African Republic is deteriorating to alarming levels, says Amnesty International today.

The organisation is particularly concerned about the sectarian violence in the capital city.

Today, the Amnesty International team witnessed 15 bodies awaiting burial outside a mosque.

Urgent priorities that need to be addressed include the lack of security in key locations, such as hospitals and internally displaced people's camps and the overcrowding in the camps.
