Chile: Amnesty International's Secretary General to meet President Bachelet

Amnesty International's Secretary General Irene Khan will meet Chilean President Michelle Bachelet on Thursday 6 November.

Amnesty International's visit to Chile begun on 3 November 2008. Since then, the delegation has met with survivors and relatives of human rights abuses and Indigenous communities in Santiago, Temuco and Calama.

19:00 – Irene Khan will open the art exhibition “30 Chilean artists in the year of Human Rights” Museo de San Francisco, Londres 4, Santiago de Chile.
